



The Annual Philippine Independence Day Golf Tournament (PIDGT)
RECOMMENDED GUIDELINES FOR THE HOST GOLF CLUB

Initial notification

All the participating golf clubs will be informed about the particulars of the tournament on or before December 15th to enable them to include this tournament in their golf schedule for the upcoming year. The PIDGT will be held on the Sunday closest to June 12 of any year.

Kick-off Meeting

The host club will schedule a Kick-off meeting of all the Presidents and/or designated representatives of all participating clubs before the end of March. The host club customarily foots the expenses incurred during this meeting. The host club will announce and review the details and guidelines of the tournament during this meeting while welcoming suggestions and opinions from the meeting attendees.

Tournament Fee

All the tournament fees collected should be spent on all the expenses that will be incurred during the golf tournament: green fees, cart fees, dinner, snacks, trophies and prizes and reasonable give-aways. The host club is not required to provide any accounting of monies collected. However, under no circumstances should the host club generate any income from the tournament fees collected. The host has the option of raising additional funds from sponsors and benefactors if so desired.

Golf Participants

Only members of Fil-Am golf clubs with established handicaps may be invited to participate in the tournament. Golfers who are not members of any Fil-Am golf clubs may be allowed to participate only if they are familiar with the USGA rules of golf.

Tournament Format

The host club will dictate how the tournament is going to be conducted including starting times and format: shotgun, double tee-time or regular tee-time. The host club will also decide how the different winners at different club or individual levels will be determined. The format will be presented and discussed during the kick-off meeting.

How to qualify as a host club

To qualify as a host club, the club must be a regular participant with a minimum of 12 players for at least 5 years in succession immediately preceding its turn to be the host.
